SUBJECT: FINANCIAL AFFAIRS

Policy 940.11 – Motor vehicle registration fees

Adopted: June 12, 1966; Revised: November 18, 1999

Statutory authority

See 20-25-312 M. C. A.

I. Board policy

The presidents and chancellors of the campuses of Montana University System are authorized to charge a motor vehicle registration fee or vehicle parking fee, or both, subject to the following procedure.

II. Procedures

- A. The president or chancellor shall submit to the Board of Regents a request to establish or increase such a fee. The president shall include with the request a description of the procedure by which the campus student governance organization, the faculty and staff were consulted.
- B. The Commissioner, on behalf of the Board, will notify the governing board of the campus student body of the proposed fee, and invite comment on the proposal.
- C. Thereafter, the Board may reject, adopt or modify the proposed fee, provided that any fee so established shall remain in effect until modified or rescinded by the Board.
- D. The monies received from the fee will be used for the development and improvement of parking lots and to strengthen the campus traffic control.
