Upon the occasion of the retirement of Stanley Rose from the faculty of the University of Montana, the faculty wishes to express its deep appreciation for his 41 years of dedicated and valued service to the University and the state of Montana by recommending that the rank of Professor Emeritus be conferred upon him by the Board of Regents of the Montana University System.

**EXPLANATION**

Dr. Stanley Rose received his PhD in Portuguese at the University of Wisconsin in 1969. He began his UM teaching career as an Assistant Professor in 1972. He was promoted to Associate Professor in 1975 and Professor in 1985. Although his degree was in Portuguese, he was equally well-qualified in Spanish and taught for the Spanish section for 41 years.

Professor Rose loved his students and he loved to teach, and his students loved him. Throughout the years, students praised him as an extremely good advisor; he received the Outstanding Faculty Advisor Award in 1999. He advised hundreds of students, not only Spanish majors and minors, but also incoming and transfer students. He also worked with many students on study abroad programs, as well as directing many departmental study abroad programs to Spain and Mexico. Professor Rose mentored all MCLL faculty members because of his long-term knowledge and experience in the department and the wider campus. He often served the role of mediator in the department with his calm and optimistic demeanor. Throughout the years, Professor Rose served on numerous departmental committees. His research interests included film studies and Portuguese language and literature.

The Department is pleased to nominate Professor Rose for emeritus status.
