Board policy:

Each unit of the Montana University System is authorized to grant Board of Regents graduate scholarships to graduate teaching assistants and graduate research assistants. The scholarships will be partial payment for the services provided by teaching and graduate research assistants. The amount of the scholarship will not exceed the amount by which out-of-state graduate tuition exceeds in-state graduate tuition. Each unit of the Montana University System may determine the number of graduate scholarships to award to teaching assistants and graduate research assistants.

Graduate scholarships were formerly included in section 11 of Residency Policy 940.1, Montana University System; Item 84-004-R0794, Graduate Scholarships, approved by the Board of Regents July 7, 1994; as revised by the Task Force on Fees Report approved by the Board of Regents on March 24, 2000 with an effective date of Academic Year 2002.
