
## Phase II: January 2017 – August 2018

- Increased focus on supporting veterans
- Continued to convene PLA Council
- Provided financial literacy workshops
- Conducted outreach to Veteran Support Agencies
- Implemented marketing campaign
- Created PLA tracking method in the MUS Warehouse
- Provided campuses with subgrants

# PLA by the Numbers

- 16,799 instances of students earning PLA credit in academic year 2017-2018
  - 4% increase over 2016-2017
  - Advanced Placement represented 82% of all PLA
- 977 of the instances were students receiving veteran benefits
  - 996 separate instances of credits articulated directly from formal military training



  - Streamline enrollment process by creating a position for a Director of Veteran Services. Providing students with enrollment checklists.
