Upon the occasion of the retirement of Dr. Sandra Bailey from Montana State University, the Board of Regents wishes to express its appreciation for her service to the University, the Montana University System, and the people of the State of Montana.

**EXPLANATION**

Dr. Bailey earned a B.A. in Sociology from Montana State University in 1988, a master's degree in Home Economics with an emphasis in Child Development and Family Science from Montana State University in 1993, and a Ph.D. in Human Development and Family Science from Oregon State in 1996. The following year she was hired as an assistant professor at the University of New Mexico, and in 1998 she accepted a position as assistant professor at Washington State University.

In 2001, Dr. Bailey was appointed Assistant Professor, Extension Family and Human Development Specialist in the Department of Health and Human Development at MSU.

In 2004 she was tenured and promoted to associated professor, and in 2010 she was promoted to full professor. From 2013-2015, she served as Head of the Department of Health and Human Development. During her time at MSU she has secured over \$3 million in total grants, published 27 peer reviewed manuscripts and has presented numerous presentations at the state, national, and international level. Dr. Bailey has a long history of professional service and commitment to the land grant mission of MSU.

For these, and other contributions, the Board of Regents of Higher Education is pleased to confer upon Dr. Sandra Bailey the rank of Professor Emerita of Health and Human Development at Montana State University and wishes her well for many years in the future.
