GEER Proposal Highlights

- OneMSU shared respiratory therapy program - \$180,000
- IT Remote Education Initiative – Missoula college with UM partners \$191,000
- Paramedicine program partnership between Flathead Valley and Miles Community Colleges - \$67,500
- Accelerated apprenticeships led by MSU Northern in collaboration with MSU partners- \$250,000
- Education Initiative led by UM Western in collaboration with UM partners - \$140,000
