Parking Services is an auxiliary fund and all revenue is used to sustain minimal staffing levels and parking lot maintenance costs for University and City College. The parking budget covers T2 parking system software, parking garage utilities, permits, snow removal, sweeping and striping, and other general operational costs. Due to an increase in inflation, Parking Services is currently unable to cover annual operational costs with the existing budget. In addition, the current budget does not allow for capital improvement projects. We have identified several parking lots on the University and City College campuses that are in dire need of major repair. Parking permit, hourly rate and fine increases would help alleviate financial strain and create possible savings for capital improvements and would help the University better serve those who park on our campuses and ultimately create a more safe/secure environment. In addition, being able to maintain our parking lots and fix areas needing repair adds to the aesthetics and is more appealing to all who visit our campuses.

The Student Health Services provides high quality, cost-effective health care and mental health counseling with an emphasis on health education and wellness initiatives to promote and enhance student success.

The current Student Health Service per-semester fee allows students access to Student Health Services from the first day to the last day of each semester. A change in our staffing structure and changing student health needs warrant an optional opportunity for students to seek or continue access to our services beyond the traditional fall/spring/summer semester schedule. Currently, there is a "gap" from the end of fall semester to the beginning of fall semester that is approximately four (4) weeks long.

In addition, there is a "gap" from the end of summer semester to the beginning of fall semester that is approximately four (4) weeks long.

With recent changes in staffing structures and our contract with SCL/Intermountain Health, we now have a Registered Nurse and licensed mental health professionals working during these periods. It is reasonable to have these medical and mental health professionals provide care to students during these times; however, the current funding and policy model requires us to either see students who have not paid any fee for these services, or, to state that per policy we cannot provide services. This can become an equity issue we wish to remedy. By providing students with an opportunity to pay an optional "Intersession" fee, all students would have access during these brief periods. To be eligible, the student would need to be registered for the upcoming semester. Payment for this optional fee would be due at the time of their first appointment, whether paid in person or billed to their student account. Just as with the regular per-semester fee, students would have access to all services and be responsible for any additional costs, such as fees for some lab tests. Since these "gap" periods are approximately one-fourth the length of the traditional semester, this optional intersession fee is approximately one-fourth of the per-semester Student Health Service fee. Offering students this option can also provide them with significant cost savings versus seeking care in the community.

The primary reason for the requested increase is to budget for inflation costs associated with inflation of utilities, supplies, maintenance, etc. has been between 10-14%. Other aspects of housing and residential life at MSUB including student staffing related to live on requirement updates. Additionally, requested fee increases will support current and long range Facility's needs. The University is also looking to appropriately adjust and meet the cost of living expenses and simultaneously competing with the housing market in Billings, Montana. According to https://www.rentcafe.com/average-rent-market-trends/us/mt/billings/ the average rent cost in the city is \$1,348.00. Even if the cost is split in half, it would still be cheaper for a student to reside in the halls as opposed to paying a monthly rent cost.

Looking at the specific 22-23 academic year, we currently have 378 students living on campus. Out of these 378, we have 180 who are on the double rate. Ifwe had the same number ofresidents on campus next year and again charged 180 with the new rate, we would be going from \$387,720 (23-24) to

\$399,420 (24-25) and \$411,480 (25-26). In order to meet our financial amount for both 24-25 and 25- 26, at max occupancy, we will need a total of 342 residents living in our double room rate.

Overall, this justification is for more students to be financially attracted to live on campus. It has been a major goal of our department to increase occupancy and having it more affordable would give more students an opportunity to live and stay living on campus for multiple years.
