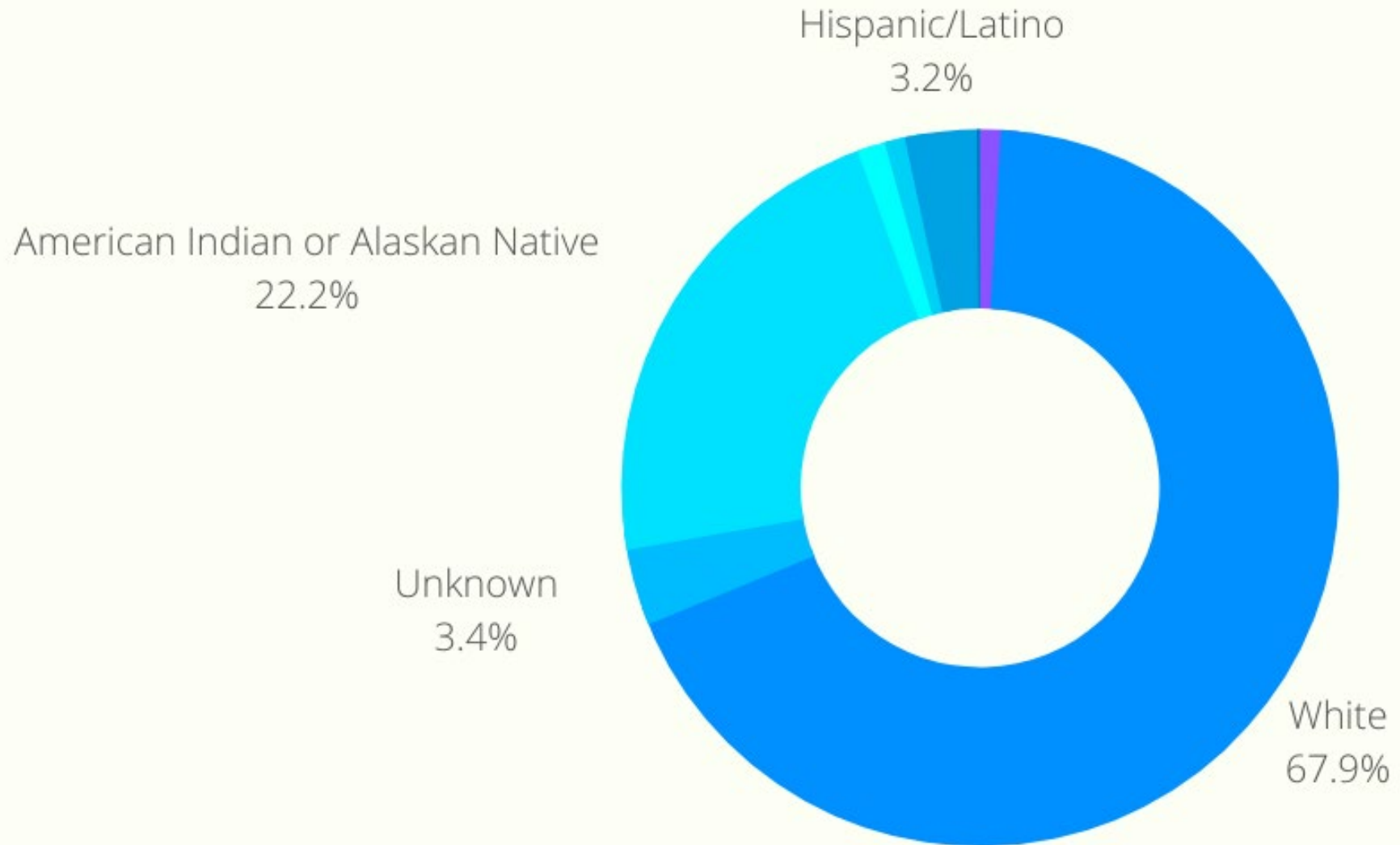

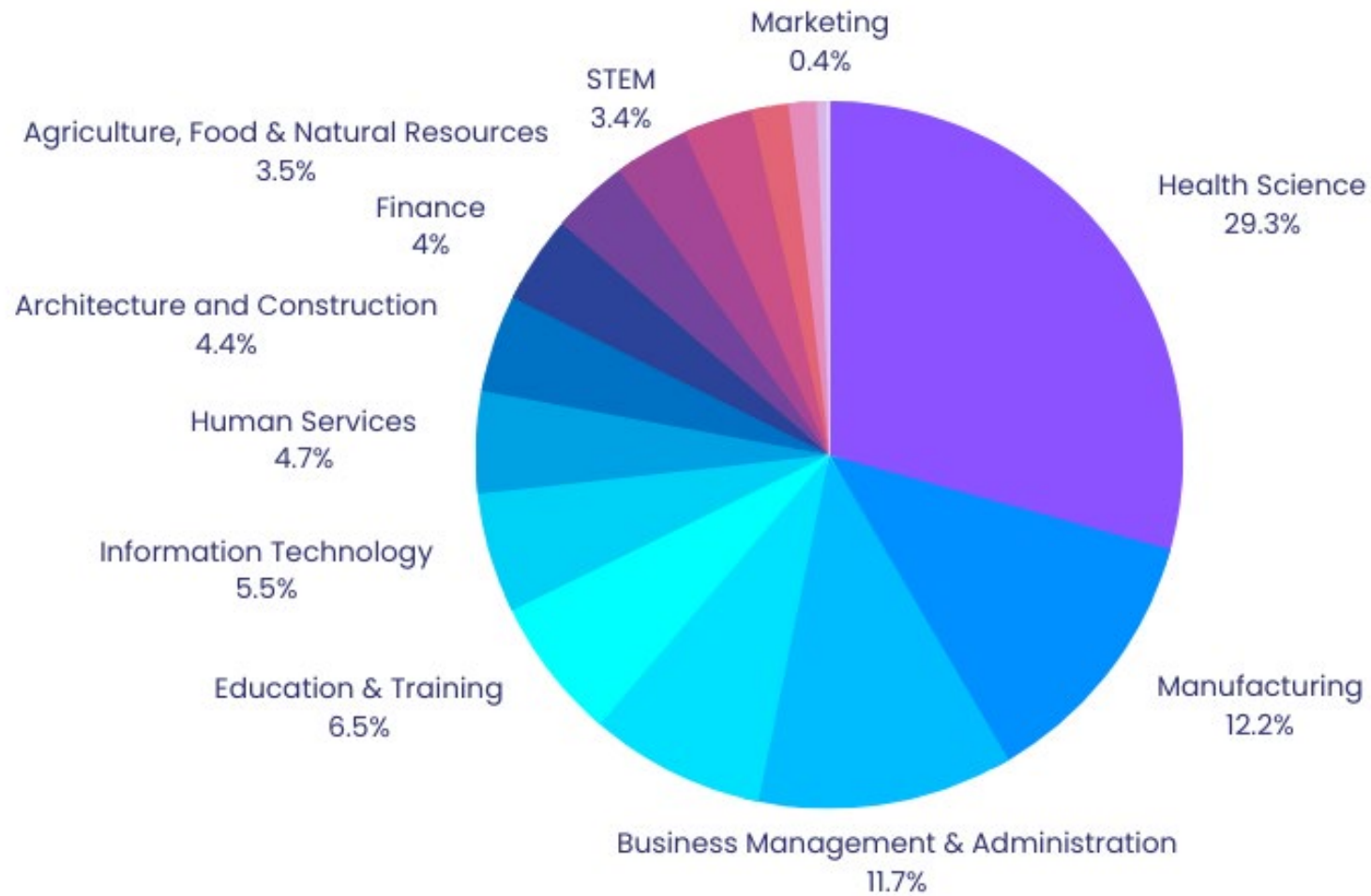


Concentrators by Race

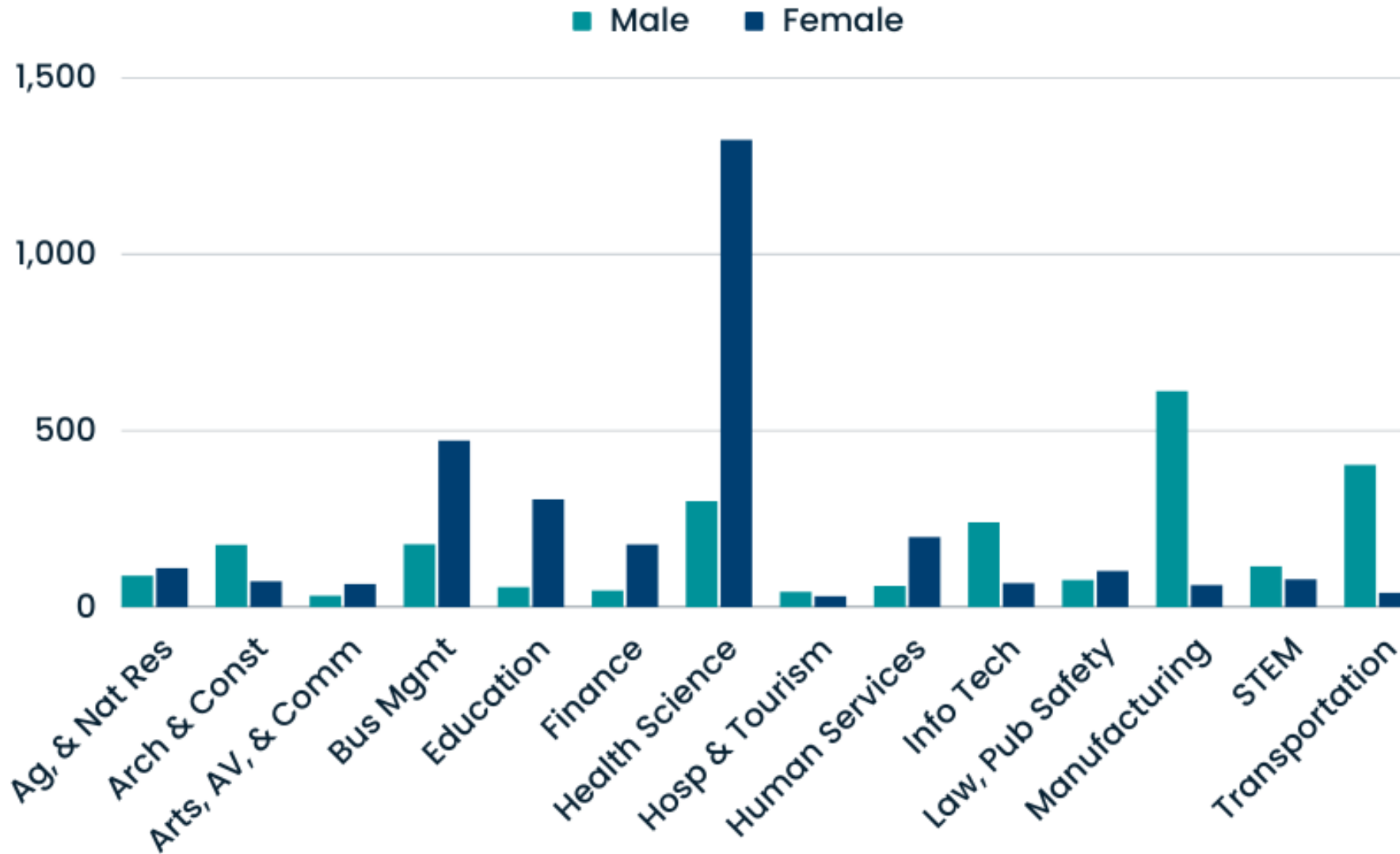

State Plan Timeline

June 2023 - Program Memo from US Dept of Education

Late Summer/Early Fall 2023 – State Plan Committee and Stakeholder Engagement

January 2024 – Public Hearing Sessions

February 2024 – Posting for 60-day Public Comment Period

April/May 2024 – State Plan Submission Due
