ITEM 209-1005-R1123 Request for Authorization to Remodel Gallagher Business Building Classrooms; University of Montana-Missoula

THAT

Consistent with MCA 18-2-102 and in accordance with Board of Regents Policy 1003.7, the Board of Regents of the Montana University System authorizes the University of Montana to expend up to \$900,000 to remodel several Gallagher Business Building rooms into a Connectivity Lab.

EXPLANATION

- 1. In 2021 per BOR Policy 940.9.2, UM utilized plant funds to hire an architect for schematic designs to update existing classroom spaces in Gallagher Business Building (GBB).
- 2. Several classrooms are outdated, under-utilized computer teaching rooms that have outlived their usefulness.
- 3. This project would remodel 4,200 SF to revitalize the space and make it a Connectivity Lab with state-of-the-art technology, new windows, lighting, finishes and furniture for students to engage in analytics, data analysis, emerging technologies, and professional development.
- 4. The new layout will be similar to that used by corporations like Google, Microsoft, Nike and Cognizant.
- UM received \$6,000,000 of legislative authority only for campus-wide classroom renovations in House Bill 5 of the 68th Legislature. UM is requesting to use this legislative authority to begin the upgrades to Gallagher Business Building.
- 6. The School of Business completed a fundraising effort for the project and funding for the project will be from private sources.
- 7. No additional operations and maintenance costs will be requested with this project.
