# Timeline Overview



## Year 1: July 1, 2024- June 30, 2025 Cycle

- Goal
  - All campuses feature Apply Montana as an application option on their website
    - Desired posting on printed and other (i.e. social media) material
- Outcome
  - Statewide consistency in Apply Montana as an option
  - Additional time for campuses to work on internal processes while advertising Apply Montana
  - Contract adjustments as campuses phase out internal applications
  - Campus input as everyone examines application and provides suggestions to streamline



## Year 2: July 1, 2025- June 30, 2026 Cycle

- Goal
  - All campuses only utilize Apply Montana for all <u>resident undergraduate</u> applications.
- Outcome
  - Single entry point for all resident applicants
  - Streamlined application
  - Unified messaging and marketing about application access

## Year 3: July 1, 2026- June 30, 2027 Cycle

- Goal
  - <u>All undergraduate</u> (including non-resident domestic and international) apply through Apply Montana

### Outcome

There is no other application for undergraduate students to MUS institutions
