ITEM 221-2006-R1125

Request for Authorization to Construct Renovations in Hamilton Hall; Montana State University

THAT

Consistent with 18-2-102, MCA and BOR Policy 1003.7, the Board of Regents authorizes Montana State University to increase its spending authority by \$5,230,000 to construct renovations in Hamilton Hall.

EXPLANATION

- 1. MSU received appropriation of \$2,400,000 in House Bill 5 from the 68th Legislature and the same amount of spending authority in BOR ITEM 206-106-R0523 to complete life-safety and related improvements in Hamilton Hall.
- 2. MSU received \$800,000 of general spending authority in BOR ITEM 215-2002-R1124 to complete additional improvements to the third and fourth floors of Hamilton Hall in coordination with the legislative appropriation work.
- 3. After completion of initial design work for the project, estimating exercises confirmed additional funding and authority were necessary to achieve the project goals and address deferred needs in the building.
- 4. MSU received an additional appropriation of \$5,230,000 in House Bill 5 from the 69th Legislature to account for the identified project needs.
- 5. The first and second floors of Hamilton Hall were previously renovated and modernized while the third and fourth floors have remained outdated and deficient.
- 6. The renovations will address life-safety, accessibility, deferred maintenance, space utilization and other deficiencies of the existing space on the third and fourth floors, bringing all of Hamilton Hall into an improved and modern condition.
- 7. The renovations will improve current utilization of Hamilton Hall and will provide spaces designed with greater flexibility for Hamilton Hall to serve the University for the future.
- 8. The project will be paid for with a combination of LRBP funds from HB 5 and facilities deferred maintenance funds.
