Request for Authorization to Repair and Renovate the Louise Shunk Day Care Center; Montana State University

THAT

Consistent with MCA 20-25-302 and BOR Policy 1003.7, the Board of Regents authorizes Montana State University to spend up to \$2,000,000 for Phase 1 to repair and renovate the Louise Shunk Day Care Center.

EXPLANATION

- 1. The Louise Shunk Day Care Center, which prioritizes service to children of students, faculty and staff, requires repairs to address deferred maintenance.
- 2. The capacity in Fall 2024 was 42 children.
- 3. MSU received Commissioner's Authority on 4/17/25 in the amount of \$500,000 for planning and design services.
- 4. Phase 1 includes repairs and renovations to the existing facility.
- 5. No additional operations and maintenance funding will be requested as a result of Phase 1.
- 6. The proposed work will be paid for using auxiliary revenue accounts and facility deferred maintenance funds.
- 7. MSU anticipates submitting a future request for Phase 2 which will add additional square footage to the facility. The facility will eventually have a capacity of up to 100 children to meet campus and community demand.
