2. Academic Planning

- Complete a revision of BOR policies related to bachelor's and graduate level credentials.
- Develop an improved framework and metrics for new program approval and ongoing review of the MUS academic program inventory.

3. Teaching, Learning and Student Success

- Support ongoing work to enhance students' early math and writing success, including through renewal of MUS math pathways and coordination with K12 on math and writing success interventions.
- Expand the Montana Online Course Exchange and improve guidelines that facilitate academic collaboration.

4. Research and Innovation

- Revise Montana's state science and technology plan.
- Monitor impacts of federal budget changes and coordinate strategic response.
