MUS AI Leadership Retreat

September 19th, 2025 – Montana Technological University

Retreat Goals:

- 1. Increase shared understanding of Al opportunities and risks in higher education.
- 2. Share current efforts and pilots underway across campuses.
- 3. Jointly prioritize areas where the MUS should act, communicate, invest, or coordinate.
- 4. Launch the work of an ongoing taskforce and working groups to discuss and deliver on priority areas.

Participants: 2-4 attendees from each campus representing leadership in academic affairs, IT, operations, research.

MUS AI Taskforce and Working Groups

Composition: 6–8-member coordinating task force with broader invitation working groups coordinated in areas of Curriculum and Instruction, Student Supports, Campus Operations, Enrollment/Marketing, and Research.

Goals: 1) promote appropriate use and adoption of AI tools by MUS stakeholders working in instructional, operational, and research areas; 2) inform strategic use of AI tools through regular discussion and assessment of AI use cases across the system and state; 3) recommend shared guidelines that assist in the ethical and productive use of AI, 4) develop recommendations for system investment, procurement, policy, and/or guidance.

Timeline:

- **Sept. 2025 –** MUS AI leadership retreat.
- Oct. 2025 Task force and working groups membership identified and initial meetings.
- March 2026 Report and recommendations to the BOR and 2nd MUS AI leadership retreat.
