Summit - MSU–Northern Chancellor Greg Kegel recently represented MSU-Northern at the National Conference of State Legislatures Higher Education Summit in Washington, D.C., Senator Becky Beard (MT SD38) invited Chancellor Kegel to join national leaders to discuss aligning academic programs with state and regional workforce needs.
